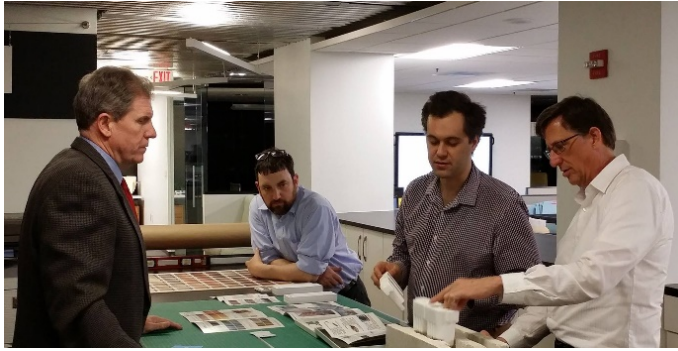
ANNUAL PARTNERSHIP (\$1,500-\$5,000)
